First Admiral Anuar was born on January 9, 1966. He joined the Royal Malaysian Navy in 1988 and commissioned as Sub/Lieutenant on June 30, 1990. Admiral Anuar holds Master of Social Science in Defense Studies National University of Malaysia and Master of Maritime Policy University of Wollongong, Australia.

Admiral Anuar has served in various appointments. Some of the notable appointments are Commanding Officer of KD KRIS, Commanding Officer of KD KEDAH, Commanding Officer of KD SRI GOMBAK, Director of Human Resource Policy and Research, Director of Naval Intelligence and Chief of Staff Naval Region 1. He was promoted to the rank of First Admiral on July 5, 2018 and subsequently appointed as Assistant Chief of Staff, Human Resource.

Admiral Anuar has attended various functional and career courses. Among others, he attended the Intermediate Intelligence Officer Course Australia, the International Maritime Intelligence USA, Submarine Fleet Manager's Training Spain, Malaysian Armed Forces Staff College and Malaysian Armed Forces Defence College.
