Dr. Ganeshan Wignaraja is the Executive Director at the Lakshman Kadirgamar Institute of International Relations and Strategic Studies in Sri Lanka. He concurrently serves as a Member of the Monetary Policy Consultative Committee of the Central Bank of Sri Lanka and the Prime Minister's Task Force on the Indian Ocean. He is also a Senior Research Associate at the Overseas Development Institute in London. In a career spanning over 25 years in the UK and Asia, Ganeshan has had senior roles in international organizations (including the Director of Research at the ADB Institute in Tokyo) and the private sector (Global Head of Trade and Competitiveness at Maxwell Stamp PLC in London). His expertise covers trade and competitiveness, global supply chains and SMEs, infrastructure connectivity, development finance and macroeconomic policy. He has published 18 books on these topics and successfully led teams to deliver complex projects in over 30 countries in Asia, Africa, Europe and Latin America. Ganeshan has a DPhil in economics from Oxford University. His latest monograph is *Asia in 2025: Development Challenges and Prospects for Middle-Income Countries*.
